



CLASS REQUIREMENTS

Class: Gone Camping

Dates: Friday 21 April

Times: 10am – 5pm

Finished size: 42cm x 64cm

You must bring along the following:

- Pen
- Notebook
- Pencil (2B), pencil sharpener, eraser, sticky tape, a black fine point Sharpie and a medium point Sharp
- A large sheet of good quality tracing paper (available from the tutor for \$3)
- Small sheet of tracing paper, A3 size (available from tutor)
- Pins
- Threads to match fabrics (40 or 50 weight), plus a reel of fine black thread (50 or 60 weight is ideal)
- Rotary cutter, board and ruler
- Fabric scissors
- Small very sharp scissors
- Paper scissors
- Quick unpick
- Tweezers
- Size 70 and 80 topstitch machine needles
- Fine fabric marking pen – eg. Sewline fabric marking pencil
- 50cm Freezer paper
- Paper backed fusible web: 2 metres of 24" Lite Steam a Seam 2 (available from tutor)

Fabric requirements

- Base fabric for campervan - dark batik or similar, 30cm
- Campervan walls, 25cm
- Campervan roof and trim, 25cm
- Wheels, 15cm
- Dark Windows, 8cm x 40cm
- White base fabric for background, 60cm
- Tree trunk fabric, 60cm
- Background forest fabrics: 6 fabrics approximately 15cm, that blend and include a range of medium-light to dark
- Foreground fabric, 25cm

- Fabric for backing, 60cm (needed in class)
- Batting, 60cm x 80cm - thin batting

To complete at home:

- Fabric for facing, 30cm (for finishing at home)

Sewing machines will be provided by sponsor companies so you don't need to bring your own. A technical assistant from that company will be available to assist any students who are unfamiliar with that machine. **If you prefer to bring your own sewing machine**, you may, but please ensure it is well maintained and that you bring the instruction manual, tools and accessories. Also, bring your 1/4" foot, walking foot and open toed embroidery foot.

Suggestions: Please make sure you label everything with your name.

- We also recommend bringing a cushion in case your chair doesn't suit your height
- A water bottle helps you stay hydrated
- Don't forget to bring your glasses
