



CLASS REQUIREMENTS

Class: Modern Colour (Colour for Quilters, with a Modern Twist)

Dates: Thursday 20 – Friday 21 April

Times: 10am – 5pm

Tutor: Julie Haddrick

Quilt finished size is 30 x 30 inches, with centre white panel 20 x 20 inches.

All fabrics are 36 inches wide unless otherwise mentioned

You must bring along the following:

- 1.5m good quality white 100% cotton fabric (used for backing too)
- 1m white fusible Pellon
- 25cm black cotton fabric for binding
- Machine threads; white and medium grey for piecing (Rasant; cotton poly)
- Quilting thread of choice, white and an invisible thread (rayon/ poly)

Border fabric - allow for two borders:

- Border 1 – outer border: Four 4 inch strips of coloured fabric.
- Border 2 – inner border four 2 inch strips of coloured fabric cut across width of fabric. Julie used the fabric *Colour Works Concepts* by Deborah Edwards of Northcott Fabric company. Fabric from this range may be purchased in class if required.
- 30 degree wedge ruler ONLY if you have one. Julie has some to share as needed.
- 18" long quilting ruler
- 6 1/2" square quilting ruler
- Cutting mat
- Rotary cutter
- Soluble fabric marking pen
- Pencil
- Coloured pencils or texta pens (eg 24 colours)
- Flower pins
- Safety pins
- Scissors
- Spare machine needles
- Bring a good number and variety of different coloured solid fabrics and low value fabrics and/or small scale geometrics like spots/stripes. Amounts need to be large enough to cut into 6" squares. Perhaps purchase minimum cut fabric pieces like 7" strips or 20cm, or consider fat quarters. Include some solid fabrics in light, medium and dark toned colours. Include Neutral coloured fabrics- greys, black etc.
- Materials cost: \$20.00** – This covers a set of Julie Haddrick's 'COLOUR & EXERCISES FOR TEXTILE ARTISTS' coloured printed notes, and 36 fabric swatches to make a colour wheel. Please ensure that you bring the **exact** amount in cash in an envelope with your

name, the tutor's name and the class name on the front, to be given to the tutor before the class starts.

Sewing machines will be provided by sponsor companies so you don't need to bring your own. A technical assistant from that company will be available to assist any students who are unfamiliar with that machine. **If you prefer to bring your own sewing machine**, you may, but please ensure it is well maintained and that you bring the instruction manual, tools and accessories. Also, bring your 1/4" foot and walking foot.

Suggestions: Please make sure you label everything with your name.

- We also recommend bringing a cushion in case your chair doesn't suit your height
- A water bottle helps you stay hydrated
- Don't forget to bring your glasses
