



CLASS REQUIREMENTS

Class: Create Interest with Rulers & Fills

Dates: Sunday 23 April

You must bring along the following:

- A practice quilt sandwich.
To make this take one 50cm plain fabric piece x the width of fabric; please use plain fabric so you can see your quilting. Make a quilt sandwich with a 50cm x 55cm piece of batting. Please use good quality fabrics not tightly woven homespun.
- A 'good copy' Quilt Sandwich.
To make this take 2 x one metre square fabric pieces; please use plain fabric so you can see your quilting. Make a quilt sandwich with a 1 metre square piece of batting. Please use good quality fabrics not tightly woven homespun.
- Rasant thread to match your fabric sandwiches: choose any colour you like however Paula prefers Rasant as it works beautifully on the Sweet Sixteen. To get the most out of your class time Paula highly recommends you use this brand. Prewound bobbins will be supplied.
- Fabric marking pen or pencil
- Thread snips or scissors
- Notepad and pen
- Some Handi Quilter long arm rulers will be available to share at the class, however if you have any 'Long Arm' Rulers please bring them along to the class to save you having to wait for a ruler. The main rulers Paula recommend are the Versa Tool, an F Wave 4" ruler and an Oval or Arc Ruler.

Sewing machines will be provided by sponsor companies so you don't need to bring your own. A technical assistant from that company will be available to assist any students who are unfamiliar with that machine. Students will be working on the Sweet Sixteen sit down long arm machine.
