



## CLASS REQUIREMENTS

### Class: Pet Portrait

Dates: Thursday 20 – Friday 21 April

#### You must bring along the following:

- Threads from your individual thread list, which Sonya will provide for your own pet photo
- Thread stand (if you have one)
- Good quality print of your photo to use as a guide
- Heavy Tearaway 25cm
- Iron-on Tearaway 20cm x 28cm
- Sewing machine needles embroidery, Size 70 - 80 or topstitch needles size 70
- Micro Pigma pen black size 0.5
- Scissors – small sharp
- Materials cost: \$10.00** – For pet's photo printed onto treated fabric (supplied).

Please ensure that you bring the **exact** amount in cash in an envelope with your name, the tutor's name and the class name on the front, to be given to the tutor before the class starts.

#### Optional:

- Fabric glue
- Background fabric minimum size 26cm x 30cm (if you decide to cut out your thread painted animal and mount it on a background)
- iPad, tablet or smart phone with your pet photo on it for reference

To complete the project at home (not required for class) you will need:

- Border fabric
- Cotton wadding
- Cutting board
- Backing fabric
- Rotary cutter
- Patchwork ruler
- Quilting pins

**Sewing machines** will be provided by sponsor companies so you don't need to bring your own. A technical assistant from that company will be available to assist any students who are unfamiliar with that machine. **If you prefer to bring your own sewing machine**, you may, but please ensure it is well maintained and that you bring the instruction manual, tools and accessories. Also, please bring along your open toe free motion foot.

**Suggestions:** Please make sure you label everything with your name.

- We also recommend bringing a cushion in case your chair doesn't suit your height
- A water bottle helps you stay hydrated
