



## CLASS REQUIREMENTS

### Class: Layers – Colour, Shape, Texture & Form

Dates: Thursday 20 – Sunday 23 April

Times: 10am – 5pm Thursday and Friday

Times: 9am – 5pm Saturday and Sunday

#### You must bring along the following:

- Basic sewing supplies
- Quilting foot
- Disappearing marking pen (air)
- Sanford overhead transparency marking pen – black with fine point
- Plastic drop cloth (white or clear)
- Apron
- Old towel
- Roll of paper towel
- Good quality paint brushes for acrylic paint. Velda uses a 1 1/2" and 1/2" "FLAT" for most of the painting
- Embroidery hoop – to be used for painting techniques, 14" size
- 2 metres of (Pellon or paper) product you prefer, to make patterns.
- 2 containers for water (one cup size)
- White plastic or foam plates for paint palette (disposable)
- Thin cotton batting (how much depends on the size of your piece). Velda suggests 2 metres square
- Fine spray bottle for water

#### FABRICS

Bring fabrics that relate to your chosen subject. Hand-dyed fabrics work best (or solids), in a wide range of colours and values. **NO PRINTS!**

Also bring one metre of black and 3 metres of white which will be used for painting. A large piece of flannel (or alternative) may be useful for 'working on the wall'.

**Materials cost: \$30** for paint, inks, pencils, cheesecloth, plastic for overhead projector and additional art supplies that will be shared. Please ensure that you bring the **exact** amount of cash in an envelope with your name, the tutor's name and class on the front, to be given to the tutor before the class starts.

- You will be working with acrylic paints. You are recommended to not wear your prom dress!
