Have you booked your social functions?

Please check your AQC itinerary: did you book the **Welcome Cocktail Party**, the **Gala Dinner** and **lectures**?

Even though Gold Passes and Two-Day packages include various social functions (depending on which pass is purchased), you still needed to **BOOK** them to claim your place.

Check your emailed confirmation to make sure they are listed so you will be allocated a ticket. The Gala Dinner does sell out and if you have not booked your place you may **NOT** be able to attend.

FAQs

I HAVE BOOKED, BUT HAVEN'T RECEIVED ANYTHING?

WHEN DO I GET MY REGISTRATION PACKAGE, TICKETS & BADGE ETC?

When you arrive at AQC, come and register at the Help Desk.

We'll have your Delegate Pack with your itinerary, classroom locations, Gold Pass or Two-Day badge and your function tickets waiting.

WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING TO CLASS?

All classes have some requirements that you need to bring – either cash for a kit or materials provided by the tutor, or a list of materials for the class, or a combination of both.

All the Class Requirements are on our website, linked to the class you booked – go to www.aqc.com.au then The Convention menu tab and find Classes on the drop-down menu. At the end of the description is the list of Class Requirements.

You'll get a shopping opportunity on Thursday and Friday from 8.30am in the VIP preview if you can't find all you need beforehand.

DO I NEED TO BRING A SEWING MACHINE?

All classes where a machine is required will be set up with machines for students – you don't need to register or request one.

If you want to bring your own, that's fine but no technical assistance will be available, and according to the venue Workplace Health & Safety regulations they will need to have a current tag showing that the appliance has recently been safety tested by an electrician.

YOUR AQC CHECKLIST

- ✓ Check your itinerary and make sure you've booked your social functions
- ✓ Gather your class requirements together and organise them (snaplock bags?)
- ✓ Pop any class fees into an envelope with the right change
- ✓ Advise us of any medical dietary requirements
- ✓ Book your transport and accommodation
- ✓ Take out travel insurance in case an emergency prevents you from attending (unthinkable but it can happen)

I HAVE DIETARY REQUIREMENTS...

If you have not already done so, please advise us if you have medical dietary requirements. You will then need to make yourself known to the wait staff at each meal so they can locate your special meal for you.

ARE THERE LOCKERS?

There are no storage facilities in the building, however you are welcome to leave your sewing gear in your classroom during breaks and overnight for multi-day classes, however no responsibility is taken and you do so at your own risk. A lockable trolley bag is a good idea for security of your belongings. During the day we operate a Cloakroom Service for luggage and coats at our Help Desk; the cost is \$2.

WHERE CAN I FIND AN ATM?

There is now an ATM in the Royal Exhibition Building, as well as the Museum opposite.

CAN WE STAY IN THE CLASSROOM AFTER HOURS?

For security and Workplace Health Safety reasons there is no access to your classroom after the class finishes on any day during the convention.

WHERE ARE THE SOCIAL FUNCTIONS HELD?

Everything is under one roof. All the social functions are held in the same venue as the classes, expo and quilt show – the magnificent Royal Exhibition Building.

I CAN'T MAKE IT TO REGISTER BEFORE THE COCKTAIL PARTY. CAN I STILL ATTEND?

Yes, see a staff member at the entry so they can check your name on the list of attendees.

WHAT IS THE DRESS CODE? We're not prescriptive but people often ask

Gala Dinner: Cocktail wear or party frocks are fine.

The Welcome Cocktail Party: dress code is smart casual but come as you are is fine.

In class: be comfortable – and if you are using paint or dye, you may want to bring an apron or cover-up.

Wearing layers helps adjust to Melbourne's changeable daily weather – the venue is NOT air-conditioned.

SAFETY AT NIGHT

During the orientation session, we will be encouraging delegates to find a buddy to walk home with after social events. If you have friends at AQC, consider buddying with a newbie who may be on her own!

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 19: 4.30PM TO 5.30PM: Registration Desk opens, then every morning from 7.30am. One of our staff will be there at all times to assist you.

NOTE: It is a lovely historic building but there are drawbacks – there are NO toilets in the foyer during Registration on Wednesday afternoon and due to OH&S regulations and forklifts operating, delegates cannot enter the interior of the building. Toilets are available at the Melbourne Museum opposite until 5pm.

We'll be Meeting the Tutors, and there'll be some fantastic entertainment – try to be there! Cocktail food and drinks will be served at this event – it does not include dinner.
