



CLASS REQUIREMENTS

Class: Quilting Vintage Linens

Dates: Friday April 6, 2018

Times: 10am - 5pm

You must bring along the following:

- A pretty linen piece, please look for a doily/placemat with cutwork/embroidery which also has large fabric areas to quilt in. Full crochet doilies are not suitable. The tutor will bring some to purchase if you cannot find anything suitable.
- 50cm (approx) fabric (eg cotton used for patchwork) to mount the doily/placemat on (plain or mottled is best)
- Backing fabric slightly bigger than your mounting fabric
- Polyester or wool/poly blend batting same size as your backing
- Cream or white thread to blend with linen background (rayon, trilobal polyester or Rasant)
- Rasant sewing thread to blend with background fabric
- Water soluble and vanishing fabric marker
- Sketch pad and lead pencil
- Thread snips
- Straight quilting ruler (optional only, handy for crosshatching)

Long-arm Sweet Sixteen (sit-down) machines will be provided for use in this class.

Suggestions: Please make sure you label everything with your name.

- We also recommend bringing a cushion in case your chair doesn't suit your height
