



CLASS REQUIREMENTS

Class: Foundation Paper Piecing

Dates: Saturday April 7 and Sunday April 8, 2018

You must bring along the following:

FABRICS

The tutor has listed the fabrics she used in her quilt. You are most welcome to substitute these fabrics for your own preferred fabrics.

- For our class you will only need a selection of about 10 to 20 fat quarters

- 1 to 2 metres of your chosen *Background fabric, Paula used grey, but white or black look equally as good. Bring 1 to 2 metres of this fabric to class.

General Requirements:

- Notepad and pencil for taking notes
- 1 metre Freezer Paper
- 18 inch or 24 inch ruler
- Add-a-Quarter Ruler
- Sharp pencil, Paula prefers a mechanical pencil as they are sharp and this will keep your lines accurate.
- Good quality machine thread in a neutral colour. Paula prefers a fine thread: 50 weight is best but regular 40 weight is fine.
- Cutting mat, rotary cutter with new blade
- Scissors, small thread snips are perfect

To complete the project at home you will need **these fabrics:**

Background Fabric:

*3 metres minimum, bring 1 to 2 metres to class (If you plan to use this fabric for your border please allow an extra 75cm and disregard the border fabric requirements)

Piecing Fabric:

Fat quarter bundle of Tula Pinks Slow and Steady

Extra Piecing Fabric:

1 x Fat Quarter Tula Pink True Colours Ladybug in Lava PWTC027.Lava

1 x Fat Quarter Tula Pink True Colours PWTPTC028.AMBER

1 x Fat Quarter Tula Pink True Colours Mini Owl PWTC026.orchid

50cm (20") Heather Bailey - True Colors - Spark - Sunshine PWTC037.SUNSH

1 x Fat Quarter Amy Butler Lotus - Full Moon Polka Dot Tangerine AM13.Tang

Border Fabrics:

50cm (20") Tula Pink - Slow & Steady - Tortoise Shell - Asphalt PWTP091.ASPHA

50cm (20") Tula Pink - Slow & Steady - Clear Skies - Strawberry Kiwi PWTP088.STRAW

Backing Fabric:

2 metres (80") x Tula Pink Free Fall Navy QBTP001.NavyX

Binding Fabric:

50cm x Width of Fabric (20") – Fabric of your choice
