



CLASS REQUIREMENTS

Class: Mini Modern Improv: Explore Frameworks

Fee \$10: pay direct to tutor includes a set of colour printed teaching notes; fusible interfacing for applique. Please have the exact amount in an envelope with your name on it.

You must bring along the following:

FABRIC

- 20 or so fat ¼'s or ¼ metre strips (and some extra scraps) of a broad selection of solid cotton fabrics in your favourite colour palettes that include warm, cool, pale, dark as well as modern low volume prints like spots, dashes, text fabrics, tone on tone. Wonky log cabin fabrics were from a layer cake
- ½ metre bold printed fabric ... see the circle sample block that has large, bold motifs. This was Maze and Vale hand printed fabric but commercial fabric will work too.
- 3 x ½ metre lengths of background fabrics: solid cotton or linen
- Sashiko or cotton threads in 1 x neutral and 1 x bright colour
- Small pieces bold-coloured stripe fabric: for strip inserts, eg 12 x 2 inches

GENERAL SUPPLIES

- 2B lead pencil, fine black marker
- Notebook and pen
- Fabric marking pen, eg blue water soluble
- Large rotary cutting mat
- Rotary cutter with spare blade
- Medium quilting ruler, eg 24 x 6 inch
- Fabric scissors
- Flower pins, quick unpick and usual sewing tools
- Safety pins
- Quality grey cotton thread for machine piecing
- Cotton threads to match background machine pieced fabrics
- 1 metre Pellon, can be with adhesive
- Universal machine needles
- 1 metre portable design wall: eg white flannel sheeting or fluffy backed tablecloth
- Spray starch, eg Mary Ellen's Best Press or similar

Requirements to complete the project (at home):

- Pellon
- Backing fabrics
- Quilting threads

Sewing machines will be provided by sponsor companies so you don't need to bring your own. A technical assistant from that company will be available to assist any students who are unfamiliar with that machine. **If you prefer to bring your own sewing machine**, you may, but please ensure it is well maintained and that you bring the instruction manual, tools and accessories, **including straight stitch foot, ¼ inch foot, open toe foot and walking foot.**

Suggestions: Please make sure you label everything with your name.

- We also recommend bringing a cushion in case your chair doesn't suit your height
