



CLASS REQUIREMENTS

Class: Daisy Paths Cushion

Dates: Thursday April 5 - Friday April 6, 2018

Times: 10am - 5pm

Tutor: Deborah Louie

Materials/kit cost: pay direct to tutor \$40 for 68 page colour instruction book, full size patterns and 7 piece template set. Please have the exact amount in an envelope with your name on it.

You must bring along the following:

- Appliqué pressing mat, small personal iron if you have one
- Nine 30cm width of fabric pieces in grey fabrics (or your choice of colour) for path blocks
- 1.0 metre fusible lightweight interfacing
- Please cut your grey fabrics equally into 36 x 4½ inch squares, 36 x 4-inch squares and 36 x 4-inch squares from the fusible interfacing before class

- Eight pieces of 20 x 25cm, (8 x 10 inches) of light, medium and dark turquoise fabrics (or your choice of colour) and one contrast colour for the flowers
- 20cm black fabric for leaves and flowers centres
- 70cm square backing fabric
- 70cm square of wool/polyester batting
- 1 metre paper backed fusible webbing (Vliesofix) for daisies
- 50cm length of pre-made black fusible bias **or** 1 packet of fusible black ¼ inch bias **or** bias maker ¼ inch size and an extra 30cm of black fabric
- 1 reel of grey 50 weight cotton thread for piecing and 1 reel of white bobbin fill thread
- 1 reel of Superior Threads MonoPoly clear thread. **Please: no monofilament nylon threads.**
- Mettler Poly Sheen or rayon threads to suit your daisy fabrics for colour on colour stitching and grey for quilting on the paths
- One packet of 80 topstitch needles and quilting gloves
- Two 30cm squares of any colour fabric to practice free motion quilting

Requirements to complete the project (at home):

3 metres of pom-pom trim

Two 70cm squares of grey fabric, 70cm square batting for back cushion

Sewing machines will be provided by sponsor companies so you don't need to bring your own. A technical assistant from that company will be available to assist any students who are unfamiliar with that machine. **If you prefer to bring your own sewing machine**, you may, but please ensure it is well maintained and that you bring the instruction manual, tools, accessories, stitch selection guide

plus **open toe embroidery foot, ¼ inch foot and walking foot, open toe free motion foot or darning foot, knee lift if you have one.**

Suggestions: Please make sure you label everything with your name.

- We also recommend bringing a cushion in case your chair doesn't suit your height
- A water bottle helps you stay hydrated
- Don't forget to bring your glasses
