



CLASS REQUIREMENTS

Class: Love Sewing; Vintage to Modern Blocks

Dates: Thursday April 5 – Friday April 6, 2018

Times: 10am – 5pm

Tutor: Julie Haddrick

Materials cost \$20: pay direct to tutor, includes: set of colour printed teaching and pattern notes, with 6 original 'Love Sewing' patterns, lettering templates for applique and 2 layer cake recipe patterns. Please have exact amount in cash in an envelope with your name on it.

(Extra multi skill level patterns will be available for additional fee.)

A variety of Foundation Piecing and applique products to use in class A4 sizes, some pre-printed on a variety of materials including Pellon Lightweight interfacing, Floriani Stitch 'n' Wash water soluble tear away fabric stabiliser, Floriani Applique Wonder fusible webbing, Carol Doak's Foundation papers, freezer paper, applique paper, A3 copy paper

You must bring along the following:

FABRIC

1 x layer cake

A layer cake is a fabric pack of 42 x 10 inch squares. (2 ¾ metres of a co-ordinated fabric range) Julie's sample is Moda; American Jane's 'Spring a ling'. Choose any small scale print layer cake in any style; modern, vintage, brights, geometric or floral. Consider Moda's 'Merry go round', Chloe's Closet's '30's Playtime', or Bonnie & Camille's 'Basics', 'Marmalade', 'Ruby' 'Scrumptious', or Free Spirit's Tula Pink; 'Chipper', 'Eden' or 'Tabby Road'. Or Riley Blake's 'Happiness is handmade'; Andover's Alison Glass 'Sunprint'; or Tanya Whelan's 'Charlotte' layer cakes.

2 metres of background fabrics (approx): It could be one length or lots of different lengths. Eg 8 x fat ¼'s or 4 x half metres of white or grey or pale fabrics. Low volume fabric prints like tone on tone, spots, text, sewing themed prints or solid colour fabrics.

GENERAL SUPPLIES

- 2B lead pencil, eraser, pencil sharpener, fine black marker
- Small roll Cellotape or gluestick
- Notebook and pen
- A4 BANK paper pad (layout drawing paper from art supply shop or discount shop) Julie can bring extra if needed. Please email her to pre order. Cost is usually about \$7
- Fabric marking pen. Eg blue water soluble
- Small rotary cutting mat or lazy-susan style cutting mat
- Rotary cutter with spare blade
- Small quilting ruler eg 10 x 4 inch
- 12 inch quilting ruler (12 x 1 inch clear; Sew Easy brand, Olfa or just a clear office ruler)
- Fabric scissors and paper scissors
- Flower pins, Quick Unpick and usual sewing tools
- Quality grey cotton thread for piecing or thread to blend with your fabrics

If you have one: Seam presser or pressing wheel, small pressing mat (irons and Clover mini irons will be supplied in classroom)

Universal machine needles

Spray starch, eg Mary Ellen's 'Best Press'

1 metre portable design wall – white flannel sheeting or fluffy backed tablecloth

Backing fabric

Quilting threads

Sewing machines will be provided by sponsor companies so you don't need to bring your own. A technical assistant from that company will be available to assist any students who are unfamiliar with that machine. **If you prefer to bring your own sewing machine**, you may, but please ensure it is well maintained and that you bring the instruction manual, tools and accessories, including **open toe foot, ¼ inch foot and other regular feet**.

Suggestions: Please make sure you label everything with your name.

- We also recommend bringing a cushion in case your chair doesn't suit your height
