



CLASS REQUIREMENTS

Class: The Painted Landscape

Dates: Thursday April 5 – Friday April 6, 2018

Times: 10am – 5pm

Tutor: Gloria Loughman

Materials fee: pay direct to tutor \$30 materials fee for fabric paint, light stabilizer for land areas and 1 metre of 24 inch-wide Lite Steam-A-Seam 2. Please have the correct amount in an envelope with your name on it. Optional: pattern available for \$5

You must bring along the following:

- Please bring photos, pictures, sketches, or other subject material relevant to the design of your quilt. An image that includes areas of sky and water with some cliffs works particularly well. Check out class photos included.
- Pencil (2B), eraser, Scotch Tape, Sharpie brand black medium felt tipped marker
- Rotary cutter, quilting ruler, cutting board
- Pins
- Threads size 40 or 50 to match background fabrics (note: variegated threads work well)
- Black thread size 50
- Neutral colour thread for bobbin
- Machine needles: size 70 and 80 topstitch
- Fabric scissors, paper scissors, small sharp scissors
- Quick Unpick or seam ripper
- A few 2 inch or 1 inch foam brushes
- A small paint brush
- Large plastic water jar
- Plastic plate (for painting palette)
- Rag, sponge or Chux for cleaning up, apron
- Appliqué mat or sheets of baking paper
- Large sheet of white paper - needs to be at least as big as proposed quilt size

Fabric:

- 1 metre of white cotton fabric for painting
- 1 metre of white cotton fabric for the base
- 50cm of black or very dark batik fabric to go under the land areas
- Bring a range of fabrics that blend well together in the colours needed for the background and foreground elements. Batiks, landscape prints and hand-dyed fabrics can work well together with the hand painted fabrics (1/4 metre, fat quarters)

Backing and Batting

- Please bring backing fabric and batting. This needs to be slightly larger than proposed quilt size (approx 50cm by 70cm). Thin batting such as cotton works well. **Note. We will need this in class.**
- There will be suitable hand dyed fabrics for sale in the classroom
- Fabric paint will be provided by the tutor

□ Note. You may need more 24" Lite Steam-A-Seam 2 depending on the size of your project. It will be available to purchase in class.

Requirements to complete the project (at home):

Fabric for facing or borders (do not bring to class)

Sewing machines will be provided by sponsor companies so you don't need to bring your own. A technical assistant from that company will be available to assist any students who are unfamiliar with that machine. **If you prefer to bring your own sewing machine**, you may, but please ensure it is well maintained and that you bring the instruction manual, tools and accessories.

Suggestions: Please make sure you label everything with your name.

- We also recommend bringing a cushion in case your chair doesn't suit your height
- A water bottle helps you stay hydrated
- Don't forget to bring your glasses
