### **You must bring along the following:**

- Wool, cotton or denim coat or jacket with detached lining layers or no lining - no polyester
- 25cm to 50cm of various prints or scraps for flowers, swirls and birds etc.
- 3m lightweight iron-on fusible webbing, eg Pellon
- Non-stick appliqué pressing sheet
- #8 Pearl cotton embroidery thread – black
- Embroidery needles with large eye
- Optional: Beads, buttons, hot crystals or lace trim and ric rac.

### Basic sewing supplies:

- Paper and fabric scissors
- Thread for applying lace and trims
- Thimble (optional)
- Pencil with regular lead
- Fabric pencil for tracing in white, grey or yellow
- Tracing paper (optional)
- Notepad and pen
- Straight pins
- Rotary cutter, ruler and mat
- Paper bag for rubbish
