



CLASS REQUIREMENTS

You must bring along the following

- Fabric scissors, ample machine sewing thread, sewing machine needles
- Fabric for sewing including a quantity of quilting cotton in solid colours, neutrals and plains. This might be a grouping of fabric that you have put aside to make a quilt, or not. As everyone's stash differs you are welcome to contact Jess via email to discuss before the class to ensure that you bring the right mix to the class.
- Rotary cutter with new blade, cutting mat
- Square acrylic templates in various sizes
- Pins, chalk pencil, measuring tape and ziplock bags for organising bits and pieces
- Fabric, batting, felt or a flock-backed tablecloth to use as a design wall OR pin onto the black classroom walls

REQUIREMENTS TO COMPLETE THE PROJECT (at home):

- Depending on your aim, to complete an improv quilt you will need batting, backing and binding. The quilt may be machine or hand quilted. Jess is more experienced in hand quilting and can demonstrate this technique.

Sewing machines will be provided by sponsor companies so you don't need to bring your own. A technical assistant from that company will be available to assist any students who are unfamiliar with that machine. **If you prefer to bring your own sewing machine**, you may, but please ensure it is well maintained and that you bring the instruction manual, tools and accessories.

Suggestions: Please make sure you label everything with your name.

- We also recommend bringing a cushion in case your chair doesn't suit your height

- A water bottle helps you stay hydrated
- Don't forget to bring your glasses
