



CLASS REQUIREMENTS

Class: Mexican Motifs

You must bring along the following:

Choose whether you will make the quilt, cushion or bag, then bring:

For the Quilt:

Quilt measures 105cm x 112cm (41in x 44in)

- 50cm white fabric for skulls
- 75cm each of four colours for the skulls, block frames and flowers
- 1.4m background and border fabric
- If using iron-on method: 3m lightweight fusible webbing
- Optional: DMC embroidery thread #8 black for buttonhole stitch.
- Hot iron-on crystals or beads

For the Cushion or Bag:

- Store-bought plain bag or cushion or 75cm fabric for background and backing
- Fat quarter of white skull fabric
- 2m lightweight fusible webbing
- Miscellaneous scrap fabrics for flowers, leaves etc.
- Optional: DMC embroidery thread #8 Black for buttonhole stitch.
- Hot iron-on crystals, lace, ribbon, black embroidery thread, sequins etc.

Basic sewing supplies:

- Paper and fabric scissors
- Pinking shears
- Applique needles and thread

- Thimble (optional)
- Regular lead pencil
- Fabric tracing pencil in white, grey or yellow
- Applique pressing sheet
- Notepad and pen
- Straight pins
- Rotary cutter, ruler and mat
- Paper bag for rubbish

REQUIREMENTS TO COMPLETE THE PROJECT (at home):

For Quilt

- 50cm binding fabric
- 1.5m backing fabric
- 110cm x 122cm rectangle of batting

For Cushion

- One bag of polyester stuffing

Sewing machines will be provided by sponsor companies so you don't need to bring your own. A technical assistant from that company will be available to assist any students who are unfamiliar with that machine. **If you prefer to bring your own sewing machine**, you may, but please ensure it is well maintained and that you bring the instruction manual, tools and accessories.

Suggestions: Please make sure you label everything with your name.

- We also recommend bringing a cushion in case your chair doesn't suit your height
- A water bottle helps you stay hydrated
- Don't forget to bring your glasses
