



CLASS REQUIREMENTS

Class: Mexican Style Memory/Altar Quilt

Dates: Saturday April 13 – Sunday April 14, 2019

Times: 9am – 5pm

You must bring along the following:

- 50m white fabric for altar steps and candles
- 35cm dark-value fabric for outer steps
- 35cm dark-value fabric for centre arch
- 35cm fabric for the arch frame background
- 1m background fabric
- 50cm fabric for inner border frame
- 1m fabric for outside frame
- 2m lightweight fusible webbing
- Six 4in x 6in photos of loved ones transferred onto Quick Fuse Fabric Sheets for Ink Jet Printers
- White or tan sewing machine thread for piecing
- Black sewing machine thread for machine applique

Embellishment Materials

- Miscellaneous scrap prints or large print motifs: leaves, frames, heart, virgin, cross, skull, angel etc.
- Lace, ribbon, black embroidery thread, crystals, sequins etc.

Basic sewing supplies

- Paper and fabric scissors
- Appliqué needles and thread
- Thimble (optional)

- Sewing needles and sewing machine thread: black or clear for applique stitch
- Regular lead pencil, white, grey or yellow fabric tracing pencil
- Tracing paper, notepad and pen (optional)
- Straight pins
- Rotary cutter, ruler and mat

REQUIREMENTS TO COMPLETE THE PROJECT (at home):

- 1.4m x 1.7m (55in x 66in) rectangle of batting
- 3m backing fabric

Sewing machines will be provided by sponsor companies so you don't need to bring your own. A technical assistant from that company will be available to assist any students who are unfamiliar with that machine. **If you prefer to bring your own sewing machine**, you may, but please ensure it is well maintained and that you bring the instruction manual, tools and accessories.

Suggestions: Please make sure you label everything with your name.

- We also recommend bringing a cushion in case your chair doesn't suit your height
- A water bottle helps you stay hydrated
- Don't forget to bring your glasses
