



CLASS REQUIREMENTS

Class: Mum's Hibiscus

Dates: Saturday April 13 – Sunday April 14, 2019

Times: 9am – 5pm

Tutor: Deborah Louie

You must bring along the following:

- Machine and extension table if bringing your own
- One open toe free motion foot
- Two 25in squares (63cm) of background solid fabric (Deb used bright purple)
- One 25in square of wool/polyester batting
- For the hibiscus Deb used three yellows, three oranges and two deep reds. Feel free to change, we are after lights to darks in analogous colours (one side of the colour wheel)
Solids only or hand dyes - no busy prints please
- One 1 metre by width of fabric lightest lemon yellow for the outer petals
- One 50 cm square (fat quarter) of bright yellow
- One 20 cm x width of fabric of golden yellow
- One 20 cms x width of fabric of bright orange
- One 20 cms x width of fabric of dark orange
- One 15-inch x 3-inch rectangle of coral orange for stamen
- One 50 cm square (fat quarter) of dark red
- One 50 cm square (fat quarter) of deep red
- Two 7 inches (17 cm) squares of solid green fabric - one darker for the leaf
- One reel of clear Superior threads Mono poly thread
- Shiny 40 weight polyester or rayon threads to match all your fabrics including your background colour choice for the sketch appliqué technique
- One reel of white bobbin fill
- One 12in square of wool/polyester batting
- Two 12in squares of your background fabric to test quilting

- Usual sewing supplies including small sharp scissors – no rotary cutter or ruler required.

- One full colour instruction book
- Full size pattern sheets
- Fusible webbing with all shapes drawn ready for fusing onto your own fabric and stabiliser backing.

REQUIREMENTS TO COMPLETE THE PROJECT (at home):

- Two 25in squares of solid fabric for back of cushion
- One 25in square of wool polyester batting

Sewing machines will be provided by sponsor companies so you don't need to bring your own. A technical assistant from that company will be available to assist any students who are unfamiliar with that machine. **If you prefer to bring your own sewing machine**, you may, but please ensure it is well maintained and that you bring the instruction manual, tools and accessories.

Suggestions: Please make sure you label everything with your name.

- We also recommend bringing a cushion in case your chair doesn't suit your height
- A water bottle helps you stay hydrated
- Don't forget to bring your glasses
