You must bring along the following:

Product brands listed below are a guide only and you may use whatever product they have access to.

- 9 inch embroidery hoop; plastic or wooden
- A selection of rayon machine embroidery threads. Julie prefers Madeira 40 weight classic range or the polyester; polyneon or the Robson Anton ranges. Bring a variety of plain colours and a subtle variegated colours eg. for sky
- One reel bobbin thread; Superior 'Bottom Line thread' Grey colour; no.622 is a fine 60 wt filament polyester thread.
- One pack of machine needles for machine embroidery. eg Schmetz or XClasse pink shank. 70,80 size
- Small sharp embroidery scissors
- Apron
- One A4 plastic sleeve folder to store notes and paint samples
- 2B lead pencil, sharpener, eraser
- Rotary cutter, small ruler, A3 cutting mat
- Fabric marking pen

Julie will provide **all** painting tools and equipment, containers, palettes, painting mats, atomisers, sponge rollers, various paint brushes etc

All consumables for class use; all fabric paints, inks and fabric colouring pens

1 metre superior eg. Moda white cotton fabric; high thread count

1 metre garment fabric stabiliser; iron-on medium weight

Colour folio of notes, A4 patterns, paint samples and instructions

A selection of Julie's original A3 design pattern sheets with coloured reference photos.

To reduce an extensive requirements list and luggage and weight for the travellers, Julie is providing items needed to paint fabric.

REQUIREMENTS TO COMPLETE THE PROJECT (at home):

- One metre iron-on Pellon
- One metre backing fabric in a neutral colour
- Quilting is done with the above thread requirements

Sewing machines will be provided by sponsor companies so you don't need to bring your own. A technical assistant from that company will be available to assist any students who are unfamiliar with that machine. **If you prefer to bring your own sewing machine**, you may, but please ensure it is well maintained and that you bring the instruction manual, tools and accessories.

Suggestions: Please make sure you label everything with your name.

- We also recommend bringing a cushion in case your chair doesn't suit your height
- A water bottle helps you stay hydrated
- Don't forget to bring your glasses
