NOMINATION FORM: RAJAH AWARD 2020

This nomination will consist of this completed form plus supporting material to a maximum of five A4 pages.

This award will acknowledge an outstanding contribution to quilting whether it be a contribution as a quilting teacher, designer, author, historian, guild worker, retailer, etc or a combination of work in several of these areas. This award is called the 'Rajah Award' in tribute to the historic Rajah quilt made by convict women en route to Australia in 1841.

Rajah JUDGING CRITERIA

The judging panel will evaluate all nominations on the following:

How is the contribution made by the nominee different to that of others in the quilting arena?

How has the nominee demonstrated commitment to his/her work in quilting?

What are the long-term effects of the nominee's contribution to quilting?

Describe the achievements of the nominee.

Notes on Nomination for awards

- Previously nominated persons who were not award recipients may be nominated again. (To be nominated is in itself an achievement and these awards seek to recognise achievements over a period of time, particularly the Rajah Award.)
- These awards are not a state competition. They are national awards – we are asking you to look at the national picture; nominated persons do not have to come from your own state.
- Judging will be made based on nominations received. Requested items such as information, pictures etc are all part of the nomination.
